<p>11. 2011 Chair's report: Please provide a narrative of the past year's activity/successes/challenges:*</p>	<p>The year of 2011 had been a year of excitements and new opportunities. We were joined by new volunteers on annual events and celebrated the international year of chemistry. The goal of 2011 was to increase our visibility in local community and increase awareness of chemistry and science in local community through our section's involvement in chemistry education and outreach. We certainly achieved what we set out to do!</p> <p>We kicked off the year of 2011 with a joint social event with local AIChE. Members of both organizations met and exchanged ideas on how to collaborate for better results. Our career development workshop is a great example of working together. Many of our local members work in industry, career develop has been a hot topic, especially among new hires. An independent career coach, Curtis Swisher, was invited to give a 4-class workshop series, which gave helpful tips to the attendees on how to navigate for a successful career.</p> <p>Our Brazosport section has a long standing tradition of great outreach programs in chemistry. As "the usual", we co-hosted many events that provided hands-on opportunities to kids. We co-hosted with Sam Houston BSA 4-boyscout events, visited the local historical museum on Halloween showing kids the magic of chemistry, organized an interactive science day by getting kid involved and played with chemistry. All these events received great feedback from both teachers and parents. This year, we also had the opportunity to celebrate international year of chemistry. Our members participated in events all over the world, and locally, we hosted events to bring chemistry knowledge to our local community. The first quarter of 2011, we showed the chemistry of water at local sea center, where visitors were greeted with posters, and our volunteers and sea center staff gave vivid talks on the importance of water and our environment. This event was well-received by all who attended. Later the year, we hosted a scientist, Michael Poindexter, from Dow Oil &amp; Gas to talk about the little known facts of the industry. Participants were fascinated by the technologies and challenges in our energy industry. Aside from these events, we also hosted a "pennies for PUR water" project for the IYC celebration that reached out to local businesses to raise money and awareness of our planet resources and the power of chemistry.</p> <p>As part of increasing our visibility in local communities, we extended our media outreach from the conventional newsletters and webpage to facebook. Our first video/photo competition was advertised using facebook and was viewed by more than third of the member population, and liked by many of them. We also participated in an event hosted by BCPC (Brazoria County Petroleum Council) to talk about how chemistry enriched our lives. This opportunity earned us a generous donation from BCPC as well as a new partner for networking.</p> <p>We concluded the year of 2011 with laughs and recognitions at the year-end banquet. We invited our 50-60- year members and their families, local high school scholarship winners, video/photo competition participants and local partners.</p> <p>The year of 2011 has clearly be a year of excitements and opportunities. We all enjoyed the events we put on and hearing the praises from local members and residents. Looking ahead of 2012, we will continue what we have accomplished, and strive to find better ways to keep our members engaged and involved, replenish our volunteer pool and train next generation leaders.</p>

<p>b. What are your concerns and challenges?*</p>	<p>What are my concerns and challenges for 2012?</p> <p>The Brazosport Section is a medium-small section with a small geography (one county). We have a history of having a strong section with most of our membership in the industrial sector. For these reasons, we have some unique challenges. The first challenge is that not only is our section dominated by industry, we are also largely dominated by one company in particular, Dow Chemical. Our section is often seen as being an organization for Dow employees and it will be a challenge this year to reach out specifically to members at other local businesses related to the chemical industry. We cannot forget about the needs of the majority of the members, but as a section we need to reach out to all members in the section. As part of being an industry dominated section, we also need to re-examine our view of how we organize seminars and technical presentations. There has been a shift in the last few years towards more general interest seminars and events that reach a broader segment. For this reason we've been focusing on topics in the food and drink areas (wine, cheese, chocolate, beer, etc.) as well as topics that are of local concern (water, oil &amp; gas industry, etc). Another challenge is supporting the needs of our members through professional networking. Even among the population of our members that are employed by Dow Chemical, there is a growing need to be ever-more connected to our colleagues in our workplaces, in our communities and across the globe. We are currently putting a very strong effort into our public relations efforts and growing our presence on facebook and hopefully the ACS network. In addition, we regularly have a career development seminar as part of our programming and we need to be sure that we are keeping up with the ever-changing aspects of how an individual's online professional presence can affect their job marketability. As lastly, we also need to have a more organized focus on long-term planning, succession planning and engaging and retaining volunteers. This is a challenge for every section, but I believe we can make some great strides in this area through a focused and well lead initiative to engage volunteers, recognize their contributions and hopefully retain them as active members and future leaders of our section.</p>

<b>Question 1</b>	Describe how your activity advanced sustainability.
<b>Answer</b>	<p>We had three very different activities that all contributed to the advancement of water sustainability. Our 1st quarter event was "Water in our World" and was one of our IYC activities. We held it at the local Sea Center of Texas aquarium and educational center and set up a booth to interact with the public. The goal of this activity was to raise general awareness of water through posters and interactions. We had an expert to represent our local municipal water system, a person who does mission work in cambodia who talked water challenges in third world countries and how they clean drinking water for a local orphanage and a scientist/chemist from a local company to talk about water technologies.</p> <p>Our second event was Pennies for PUR Water. We raised over \$3400 from local businesses to raise awareness of issues of water on a global level. This was equivalent to 240,000 gallons of water based on 3.5 cents per packet and 2.5 galls. This contribution raised enough money to hit 16% of the national goal!</p> <p>Our third activity was our annual banquet and seminar. The title of the seminar was "Meeting the Needs of the Water-Energy Nexus" and focussed on helping people understand the connection between water and energy. Dr. Steve Gluck not only presented technology, facts and information related to this topic, he really helped our members understand how water sustainability is a global issue but there are every-day things that each and every one of us can do to make an impact.</p>
<b>Question 2</b>	Describe how your activity highlighted the connection between chemistry and sustainability.
<b>Answer</b>	<p>Water in our World had several examples of this. The most interesting one was the technology used to deliver water to a cambodian orphanage. They use clay pots with silver to filter and treat the water. It is a very simple, rugged technology and yet it saves lives on a daily basis. Municipal water purification techniques were also shown to connect chemistry and local water sustainability. In addition, a general poster was shown with general chemistry facts on water.</p> <p>Pennies for PUR Water is another obvious connection between chemistry and sustainability. The PUR packets by Proctor and Gamble allow their chemistry advnacements to purify heavily contaminated water for those in need.</p>
<b>Question 3</b>	Describe the main audiences (scientists, students, educators, policymakers, press, etc.) and messages of your activity.
<b>Answer</b>	<p>In the Water in Our World Event, the main audience was the general public and we reached out to both children and adults alike.</p> <p>For Pennies for PUR water, this initiative was mostly focussed on the local industry and scientists.</p> <p>For our banquet, this was mostly attended by local (adult) chemists and their spouses.</p> <p>As a series, we reached out to a broad contingent of our local community. Our message was simple: water is all around us and used in our daily lives. It is a local concern and a global concern. It is simple in its chemistry, yet profoundly important in so many aspects of our lives. This is a sustainability issue that we can all impact whether it be through our practices at home, our money through donations or the technology we help create in our jobs.</p> <p>For this series, we had approximately 13 member volunteers and 1 non-member volunteer. We had 40 members in attendance and 30 non-members - ~70 total!!! For Water in our World, we worked with a non-profit missionary group, the city of Lake Jackson Municipal Water System, water experts from Dow Chemical and the Lake Jackson Sea Center. For Pennies for PUR water, we raised money from BASF, Freeport LNG, Conoco-Phillips, Dow Chemical, SI Group and Perstrop.</p> <p>For the seminar "Water-Energy Nexus" we worked with Dow Chemical Fellow, Steve Gluck from Dow Water &amp; Process Solutions R&amp;D.</p>
